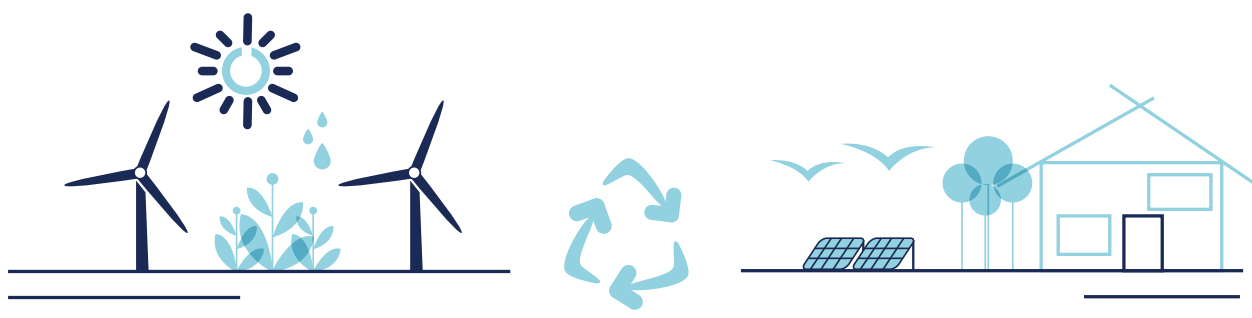
## **MEDENER INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON ENERGY TRANSITION**
