3TWINS (Yuri Zelenski) is a street art artist from Belgorod, Russia. He works in duo with his twin brother Anatoly. At the moment Yuri lives in Portugal, in Lisbon.

The creativity of 3TWINS began with a passion for graffiti. Studying architecture and overcoming the influence of subcultures, the Zelenski brothers gradually moved from the practice of writing fonts on the streets to creating large-scale abstract compositions in the context of urban spaces. The individual style of 3TWINS, shaped mainly by the impression of industrial architecture and industrial objects, also incorporates elements from the field of digital art and virtual environments.

The artistic method of 3TWINS is to interact with the urban context of a place through visual images: the shapes, light shades, outlines and textures of the surrounding landscape are the main elements of their site-specific compositions. In their work with the context of place, surrounding objects, structures, textures and colors, the artists seek to rethink the possibilities of visual perception through the visual experience of familiar spaces.

3TWINS' work can be seen in Berlin and Leipzig, Amsterdam and Porto, and in South Korea, contemporary art magazine Pinzle dedicated an entire issue to their art in 2019. At the moment, Yuri is an active artist based in Lisbon.
